

FRANÇAIS ORAL / CONVERSATIONAL FRENCH

Intermediate 2 – *En mouvement* Theme: Leisure activities

At the end of the 33-hour course, the learner should be able to say:

- I can understand simple technical or physical instructions.
- I can follow and get the general meaning of a discussion on a familiar subject.
- I can understand a short narrative.
- I can understand a number of idiomatic expressions.
- I can talk about health and physical fitness.
- I can express likes and preferences about sports and leisure activities.
- I can indicate whether an event happened before, during or after another.
- I can plan upcoming events.
- I can explain how to do something.
- I can explain a process or a series of events.
- I can show the relationship between two ideas, for example, by using *qui* and *que*.
- I can give a simple report of information that I heard or read.
- I can give orders and instructions.
- I can forbid someone to do something.
- I can check if I understand by repeating what I think I heard.
- I can use a word with a similar meaning when I don't know the word I need.
- I can express emotions and attitudes, and react to the emotions of others.
- I can talk about problems and propose practical solutions.
- I can discuss sports, physical fitness, etc.
- I can ask for or give permission or authorisation.
- I am comfortable speaking French with people I know in a familiar situation.
- I can take part in a conversation about personnel matters.
- I can follow instructions if they are written in straightforward language.
- I can scan short texts and find facts or important information, for instance in a brochure.
- I can write a short letter or email message asking for or giving basic information.
- I can write the steps for a short procedure, including several details.

Context: The subject is familiar and the other person speaks in a fairly slow, clear and simple way.
